



Historic Lincoln Elementary School Built in 1914

Bartlesville Lincoln Elementary School Scholarship Fund, Inc.

HISTORY

The Lincoln Elementary School built in 1914 is one of the oldest schools in Bartlesville, Oklahoma, U.S.A. The school was closed in 1984 and was acquired by Service and Technology Corporation – STC, in 1986 when STC was founded as a consulting engineering firm.

PURPOSE

The purpose of B.L.E.S.S. is to honor and immortalize the students and staff of the historic school by providing scholarships for college education. It is an interest free loan scholarship primarily intended for average students from middle-income families even though others are not excluded from consideration.

ELIGIBILITY

- All students shall be eligible for B.L.E.S.S. irrespective of ethnicity, color, national origin, sex, age, religion and similar considerations.
- Education in engineering, technology, science and other subjects shall be the order of priority for the award of B.L.E.S.S.
- Available financial resources and the need for assistance shall be taken into consideration.
- A minimum of 2.5 out of a possible 4.0 high school GPA or a post high school current GPA of 2.5 or more shall be necessary.
- Good aptitude and interest in the chosen field of education shall be important.
- Stability in the pursuits of goals and good work habits shall be prime considerations.

REQUIREMENTS

- Current transcript.
- A minimum of four letters of recommendations. Two of these letters shall be from school staff members familiar with the applicant and two from community members familiar with the applicant. All letters shall be from non-relatives.
- An agreement covering the loan repayment including appropriate co-signatures will be required.

APPLICATION

Applications for this scholarship may be obtained from the high school counselor's office, from STC's website www.stc-smc.com or from the B.L.E.S.S. Secretary, 105 SW Penn, Bartlesville, Oklahoma 74003, U.S.A. Completed applications must be submitted to the B.L.E.S.S. Scholarship Committee no later than June 1 each year. The application form appears on the back of this brochure. All of the required information must be provided before the scholarship committee can consider your application.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Each year the B.L.E.S.S. Scholarship Committee will select recipients of the B.L.E.S.S. Scholarship. Upon receipt of proof of enrollment at an institution, recognized by B.L.E.S.S. a check for the award amount, up to \$1,500, will be sent directly to the institution in the name of the recipient. The scholarships awarded may be extended from year to year for a period of four years, providing the recipient maintains a cumulative grade point average of at least 2.5 and remains in good standing with the institution attended. The normal cumulative award is \$6,000 per scholarship.

The four year duration and the \$6,000 cumulative total loan can be extended by the scholarship committee for graduate studies or under other special circumstances.

REPAYMENT

Two months from the time the recipient of the scholarship award ceases to be a full-time student at the educational institution, the recipient is expected to begin repayment of the award at the rate of \$100 per month to the B.L.E.S.S. Scholarship Fund, Inc. until the award is fully repaid. Extensions for the initiation of repayment will be considered by the B.L.E.S.S. Scholarship Committee under very special circumstances.
